Conflict Minerals Statement

Advanced Scientific Materials Ltd (Goodfellow) is the holding company for Goodfellow Cambridge Limited, Goodfellow Corporation, Goodfellow SARL, Goodfellow GmbH and Goodfellow (Shanghai) Trading Co., Ltd.

As a downstream supplier of tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold, also known as 3TG, we are committed to ensuring that we do not source supplies from mines that finance armed groups, use forced labour, abuse human rights, and support corruption and money laundering. Supplies that fund conflict or other illegal activities are known as “Conflict Minerals” (CM). We are working towards meeting the responsible sourcing standards set out in the OECD Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of 3TG from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas (CAHRAs).

Goodfellow rarely purchases tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold (3T&G) direct from smelters or mines. With many tiers within the supply chain that isolate us from the smelters and mines where the raw materials are sourced, we are reliant on our suppliers to determine the sources and conflict status of the 3T&G products supplied to Goodfellow.

Goodfellow expects that our suppliers can certify, or are in the process of certifying that the materials they supply do not originate from Conflict mines. We will continue to work with our suppliers to strengthen compliance and ensure that only “Conflict Free” materials are purchased.

Goodfellow has no indication that the products we supply have been sourced from mines or smelters from CAHRAs that can be shown to be funding conflict or other illegal activities.
